


Instructions for first round of counselling (UG programmes)

Candidates should read the following instructions carefully before filling the choices:

1. Choices once filled can not be changed at any stage or any round of counselling.
2. Seats will be allotted in order of preference of choices filled by the candidates subject to the availability.
3. Seat allotted to the candidate will not be changed in any circumstances.
4. Each candidate willing to participate in first round of counselling will pay a non-refundable counselling fee of Rs. 500.
5. Seat allotted in first round of counselling will be upgraded automatically if the seat of his higher choice is available in the second round. This process will continue if further rounds of counselling are carried out due to availability of seats.
6. After allotment of seat, the candidates will have to pay total university fee as per details given on the website.
7. If a candidate fails to pay the required fee within stipulated time after allotment of seat, then the seat allotted to him/her will be automatically cancelled and will go to next round of counselling.
8. If a candidate leaves the seat allotted to him/her after depositing the applicable university fee, then the seat will be cancelled and will go to next round of counselling. The fee deposited by the candidate will be refunded as per university rules.
9. * B.Tech. Food Tech. is a self financing programme for which annual programme fee of Rs. 100000.00 (Rs. One lac only) besides the semester total fee will be applicable for each admitted candidate.
10. A candidate who is allotted B.V.Sc. & A.H. seat will have to pay university fee of Rs. 57139.00 for one year (if the university does not open by that time and online classes are held from home) and fee of Rs. 61759.00 + actual food charges (if the university opens by that time and students stay in the hostels).
11. A candidate who is allotted B.Sc. (Hons.) Agri./B.Sc. (Hons.) Comm. Sc./B.F.Sc./B.Tech. Food Tech. seat will have to pay university fee of Rs. 24480.00 for one semester (if the university does not open by that time and online classes are held from home) and fee of Rs. 26790.00 + actual food charges (if the university opens by that time and students stay in the hostels).
12. Candidates are advised in their own interest to ensure that they fulfil eligibility criteria for admission to the courses for which they are filling their choices.
13. For admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. programme, minimum age limit is 17 years for all candidates and maximum age limit is 25 years for general category and 30 years on or before 31.12.2020 for SC/ST/OBC categories.
14. For admission to B.Sc. (Hons.) Agri., B.Sc. (Hons.) Comm. Sc., B.F.Sc. and B.Tech. Food Tech. maximum age limit is 22 years for general and OBC categories and 25 years as on 30.06.2020 for SC/ST categories.
